# SUSTAINMENT SERVICES



In an evolving and increasingly competitive funding landscape, raising money while maintaining daily operations can be challenging. The [Human Trafficking Capacity Building Center](#) offers no-cost sustainment services to help organizations pursue grant opportunities, engage in strategic financial planning, and identify paths towards long-term sustainability.



### Office Hours

The Center hosts open “office hours” on the third Thursday of each month from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. eastern time. During these 90-minute sessions, Center staff and subject matter experts discuss a variety of topics related to grants and sustainability and provide real-time answers to participant questions.



### One-on-one Coaching Sessions

During a 90-minute session, Center subject matter experts provide one-on-one coaching to help organizations develop strategic and sustainable approaches to fund their anti-trafficking work. Center staff and subject matter experts review program and financial materials prior to the session and bring tailored recommendations to help organizations expand and enhance their programs and achieve their sustainability goals. ### Cohort Sessions

Center staff and subject matter experts facilitate four weekly, two-hour, small group sessions for organizations new to grants and grant-writing. Building on sound program development and long-term sustainability concepts, organizations learn to find funding opportunities, assess them for feasibility, and write goals, objectives, budgets, and persuasive narratives.
