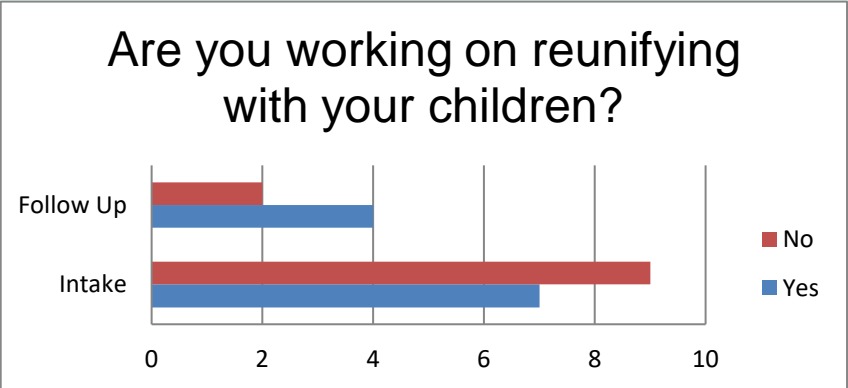
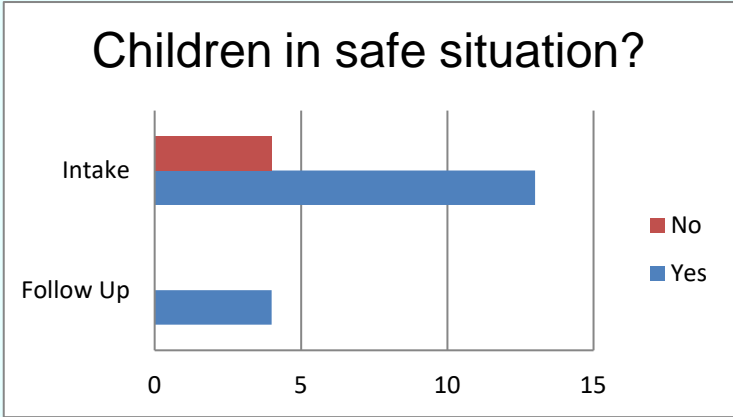
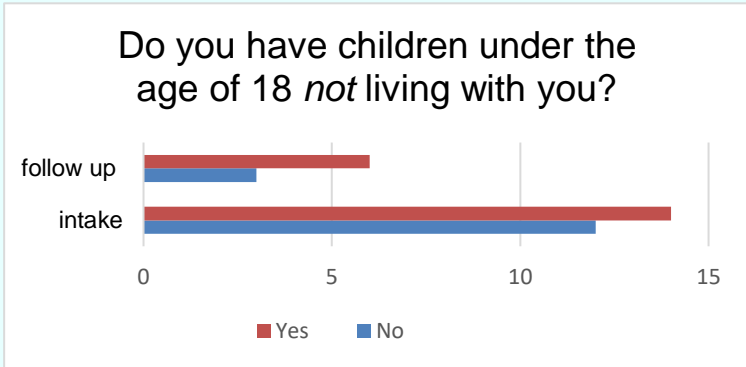
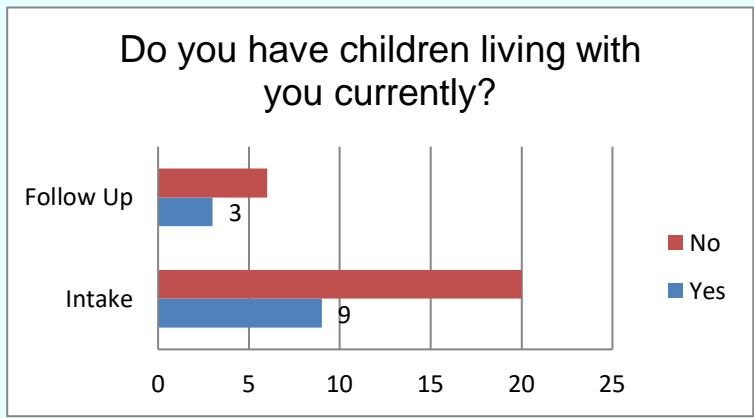


Literacy Level at Intake



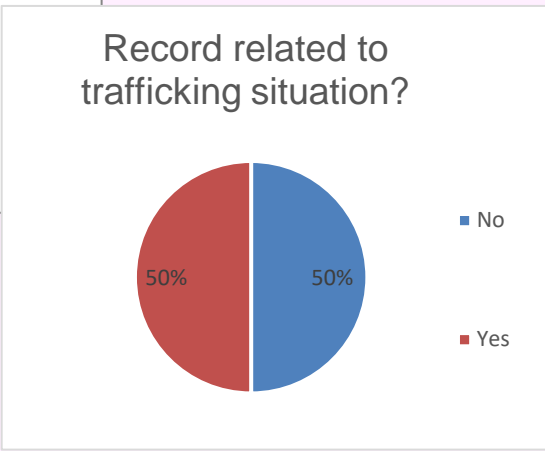
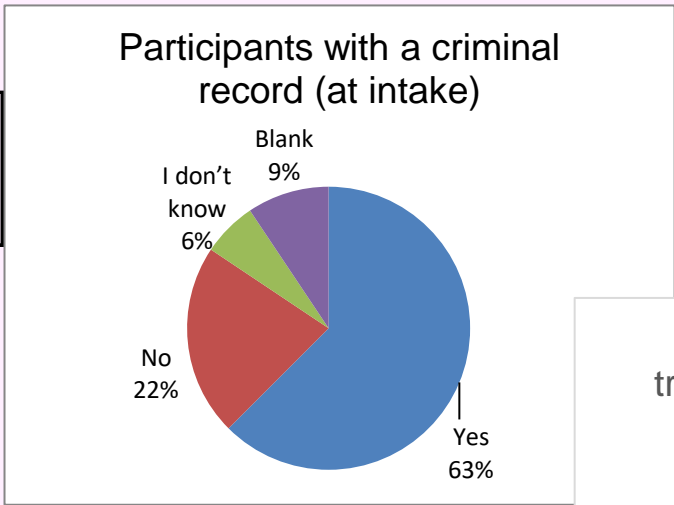

Feelings about current housing

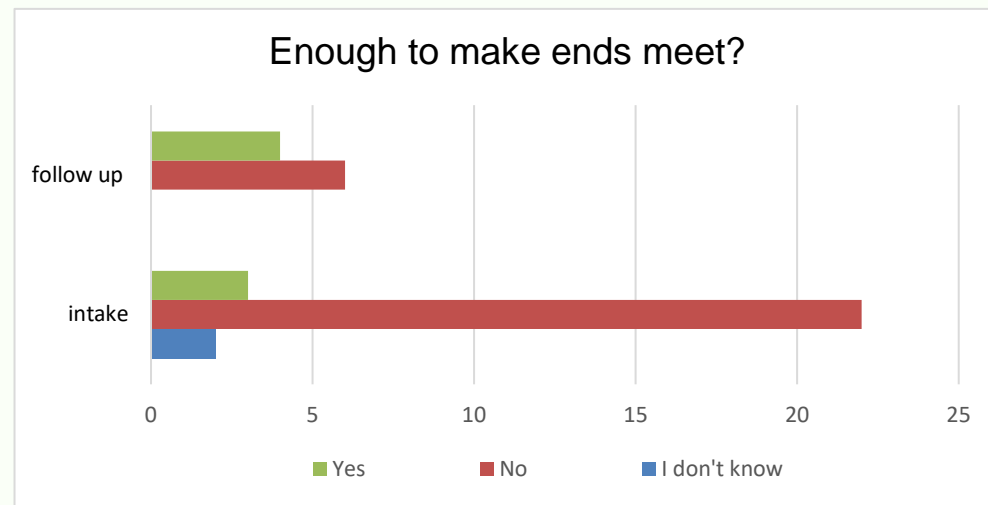
